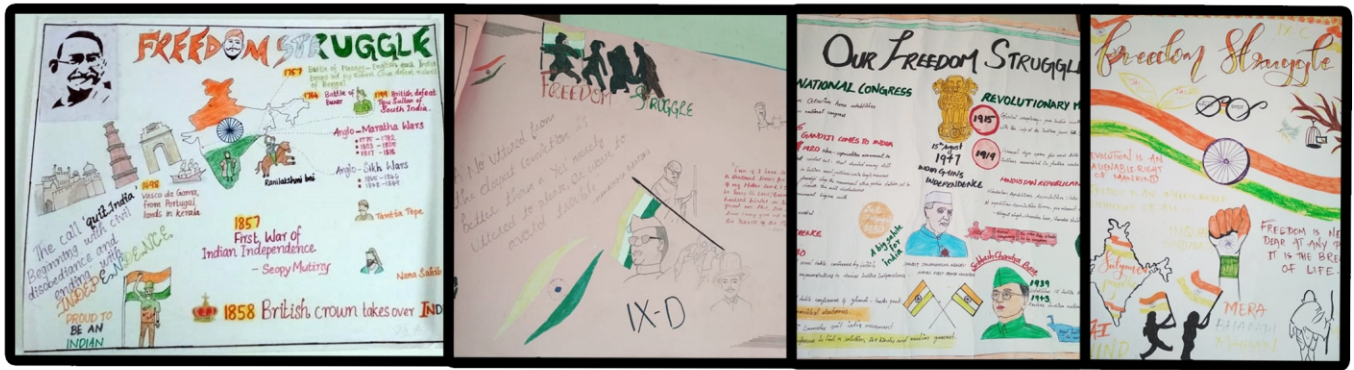
## PUBLIC SPEAKING SKILLS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM
