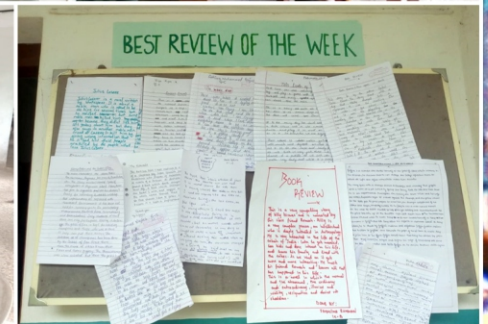
FRUITS DAY CELEBRATION
