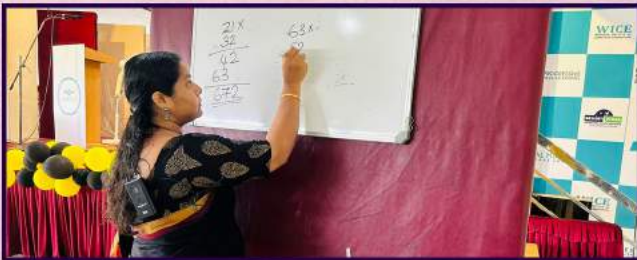


## BRAINS AND BEAUTY
